In accordance with the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) of 2009, Stakeholder Guidance the following quarterly report is being provided. Chattanooga Metropolitan Airport Authority received notification on April 8, 2009 that the airport was identified as a recipient for one \$3,000,000 ARRA grant. The approved project consists of the infrastructure development on the west side of the airport, which will include site preparation, asphalt paving, electrical lighting, markings and construction of approximately 500 feet of additional ramp with two taxiway connectors. Funding for the additional construction is 100% federal funding.


